## 1<sup>st</sup> Paragraph

**Plot Summary:** Briefly (no more than ¼ page) describe the plot of the book.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Paragraph

**Characterization:** Identify and describe the main characters. Be sure to identify the protagonist(s) and antagonist(s). Is the protagonist a sympathetic character? Are the characters believable? Etc.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Paragraph

**Theme:** What is the author's main idea(s)? What is he/she trying to say? How does he/she try to make his/her point? What literary devices (symbols, motifs, allusions, etc.) are used to convey his/her ideas? Etc.

## 4<sup>th</sup> Paragraph

**Reader response:** What do you think of this book? How did it make you feel? Did you relate to any particular character? Etc.

## 5<sup>th</sup> Paragraph

**Evaluation:** Is the author's point valid or true? Do you—as a Christian—agree with his/her views? Why or Why not?
